## **LEVEL 2 LOCKDOWN UPDATE**

It is our intention to keep children, staff and whānau as safe as possible within our school environment. We are following the advice of the Ministry of Education, Ministry of Health and Worksafe NZ.

At Alert Level 2 we will still need to ask for your assistance and support as the school routines and timetables have had to be adjusted for Health and Safety reasons.

Please be aware that sick children must remain at home until they are well and symptom free. Children attending school:

- Please farewell and pick up your child/ren from outside the school gates and ensure they know who is picking them up or if they are walking home.
- Gates will be open from 8.30am. Children should not be dropped off earlier as no-one will be available to supervise their safety. Children must be collected promptly at 3pm.
- Each child will need a school bag, lunch and named drink bottle. (School fountains will not be operating and lunches cannot be dropped off at the office.)
- Due to Contact Tracing Parents/Whānau/Visitors must telephone the office before entering the school grounds. We are trying to minimise non essential contact with others.
- Safe hygiene practices will be a priority in school. Classrooms/pods have hand sanitizer and the option of handwashing facilities. These will be monitored and reinforced by teachers and staff.
- Any child who becomes sick at school will need to be urgently collected. It is therefore critical we have your up to date contact details. (please see below)
- Distancing of students will be taught i.e. Bubble Steps to avoid breathing on one another. We are also reminding children that they must not touch each other as is our policy.
- Pandemic level of cleaning for all classrooms and school areas.

We will be closely monitoring children's well being. Accelerated learning will be a major focus for the next 6 weeks for all children and an easing back into routines.

### GLO GERM BLACKLIGHT EXPERIMENT

Over the last few days the students in Upper Explorer Pod have been learning the importance of efficient handwashing and the ability of germs to spread through cross contamination.

To demonstrate cross contamination, the children played with two tennis balls secretly sprinkled with GLO GERM which is an invisible and harmless powder that simulates the behaviour of real germs and transfers to things that are touched. After playing for three minutes, the students proceeded to do other activities as they would normally within the classroom.

After a while, a UV black light was used to track the spread of the

powder. As predicted, the light displayed the spread of the GLO GERM over the children's faces, ears, hair, clothing and all over the surfaces they came in contact with in the classroom.

This prompted us to check the effectiveness of the students' handwashing practice. They were asked to wash their hands with soap and water for 20 seconds and apply a special lotion as if it was a sanitiser. The UV black light showed areas that were missed by the special lotion. These included finger tips, between fingers, cuticles, back of hands and wrists. We will all now make sure we wash our hands thoroughly for 20 seconds!!!!

#### SCHOOL HOURS

#### **CELLPHONES**

Cellphones are not permitted at school. This is to avoid breaches of privacy, interruption of school lessons, cyber bullying and theft. Students found with cellphones will be required to hand it in to the office for parents to collect from school. In the event of emergency, family can contact the school on 2639060.

#### **UNIFORM & STATIONERY**

All items can be purchased from the school office as a convenience for parents. We ask that parents phone the office to place their order, we will email you an invoice which can be paid by internet banking and items can be sent home with children or picked up outside the gate by arrangement.
